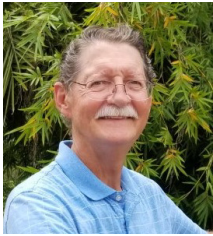

DAVID DUB-YAH'S JUKEBOX LIVE

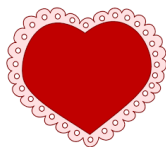
