ELKS NATIONAL FOUNDATION

While Elk's National Foundation (ENF) spending has tripled in the past couple of years Orlando Lodge members donations have declined. Each member is expected to donate \$4.80 to the ENF this year. The money is used to support communities, scholarships, and veterans across the country. This past year the ENF gave away over 40 million dollars to support such programs.

On the other hand, our Lodge has only donated \$150.00 to the program. That is an average of only \$0.45 per member. Our goal is \$1900.00. In our district we are sixth out of six Lodges, and in the state, we are 73 out of 92 Lodges.
